## THE KU KLUX KLAN CEREMONIAL ADMINISTERED TO 200 BOULDERITES AT A PLACE IN THE COUNTRY FIVE MILES NORTH OF THE CITY

It was reported to the telephone this morning that a hundred masked men of the Ku Klux Klan held a ceremony five miles north of the city last night between midnight and one o'clock. More than fifty automobiles were used in conveying the Klan to the scene of the ceremony which was on an abandoned road, east of Twelfth.

The Camera's informant stated that a flash light was taken of the group and was to be turned over to the paper for publication. This has not been done. A few members, unmasked, were

by required to turn their backs while the photo was being taken. A white cross was used in the ceremony.

Rumors have been rife of the formation of such an organization in Boulder. The call of the grand jury urged that that body investigate reports of the formation of such an organization here. The jury has not done anything as yet, it is said, by those who are close to the officers of the law. Members of the sheriff's office and others asked today stated that they knew nothing of such a meeting.

A prominent citizen of Boulder received a warning signed by the Klan a few nights since. It had been shoved under his office door. He regarded it as a practical joke by some friend.
